After 21 months the three-man Apollo space capsule had undergone a transformation. Over 1300 modifications had

As a result, in the third book of the series, the *Wishsong of Shannara*, Brin and her brother Jair were recruited by the Druid Allanon to seek out and destroy the Ildatch, the book of dark magic that had subverted the Warlock Lord, and was now doing the same with the Mord wraiths.
